Many young people who qualify for Secondary School are unable to afford the school fees. Some are from poor farming families, others are orphans. Just £30 will provide a bursary for uniform & materials. So £5 a month will help two students.

What is the FUM Secondary School Sponsorship Project ?

This project started to support students from poor families — many of them orphans as a result of AIDS (and other causes) - in a large primary school – Imeli Primary in Nzega in the Tabora Region of Tanzania. The project started in 2003. It is exciting to note that out of the first group of 18 students to benefit from the project 3 completed 6th form education. So far approximately 400 students have been enabled to attend secondary school.

This is what one of the students wrote:

“ Now I am a form six leaver. I completed my advanced level on February 2010 at Sengerema High School. ... I was studying physics, chemistry and biology. In April 2010 my form six results were out and I got division three.

In May 2010 I sent university applications to different universities and colleges here in Tanzania and now am waiting for the selections. What I hope for the future is to become a doctor who will be more capable of serving many people like pregnant mothers and children who are daily dying with curable diseases like malaria especially in my country and in Africa.

On behalf of my fellow students who were sponsored by FUM from 2003 up to 2010 I send my thanks to you and all other members of FUM. ”

What does it cost?

The commitment to sponsors for sponsoring a student through secondary school is only £30 a year for 4 years. This will provide a bursary for uniform & materials. Well under £1 a week from your pocket will give someone a real chance in life.
