## Have you thought about giving to FUM through your Will?

Including a gift in your Will is a simple way of helping the people in the Tabora Region of Tanzania. FUM is run entirely by volunteers so can ensure that all of your gift would go to a local project in Tanzania.

### How can I include a gift to FUM in my Will?

It is simple to leave a gift to FUM in your Will. Ask your solicitor to include a gift when drafting your Will or, if you already have a Will, simply fill out the example codicil opposite and keep it with your Will.

### Are there tax advantages to leaving a charitable gift in my Will?

Yes: gifts to a charity made in a Will are exempt from Inheritance Tax. Inheritance Tax is usually payable on an estate when the net value of the estate exceeds the Nil Rate Band. Your heirs will only be taxed on your estate and assets over the Nil Rate Band AFTER any gifts to charity have been deducted. Your solicitor or accountant will be able to provide you with further information about this.

### Do I need to inform FUM if I leave a gift to them in my Will?

No, you do not have to tell us of your decision (although we would like to be able to thank you for the gift). We also understand that your circumstances may change and this could result in you removing your gift to FUM from your Will.

Example wording for your **Will**:

I give to the Friends of Urambo and Mwanhala (Registered Charity Number: 265345) of Tanner House, Sissinghurst Road, Biddenden, Kent, TN27 8EX, (either) .....% of the residue of my estate, (or) the sum of £....., free of all taxes for its general purposes and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.

Example wording for a **Codicil** to leave with your Will:

I [YOUR NAME] ..... of [YOUR ADDRESS] .....

declare this to be the [FIRST/SECOND] codicil of my Will dated [DD/MM/YYYY]. In addition to any legacies given in my said Will I give to the Friends of Urambo and Mwanhala (Registered Charity No: 265345) of Tanner House, Sissinghurst Road, Biddenden, Kent, TN27 8EX, .....% share of my estate, **or**<sup>†</sup> the sum of £....., to be used for its general purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.
